### **Section 7 – Preventive Measures**

#### PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

GLOVES (SPECIFY)

Impervious gloves (vitron, nitrile) should be worn at all times when handling this material.

#### RESPIRATORY PROTECTION (SPECIFY)

If exposure exceeds occupational exposure limits, wear a NIOSH APPROVED respiratory apparatus. Use either an atmosphere supplying respirator or an air purifying respirator for organic vapours. Proper equipment for high concentrations includes an atmosphere supplied, positive pressure demand, self contained or airline breathing apparatus.

#### **EYE PROTECTION(SPECIFY)**

Chemical safety goggles and/or full face shield to protect eyes and face, if product is handled such that it could be splashed into eyes. Provide an eyewash station in the area.

Issue warning "COMBUSTIBLE". Eliminate all ignition sources. Handling equipment must be grounded. Isolate hazard area and restrict access. Try to work of spill. Avoid direct contact with material. Wear appropriate breathing apparatus (if applicable) and protective clothing. Stop leak only if safe to do so. Dike and contain land spills; contain water spills by booming. Use water fog to knock down vapours; contain runoff. For large spills, remove by mechanical means and place in containers. Absorb residue or small spills with absorbent material and remove to non leaking containers for disposal. Recommended materials: clay or sand. Flush with water to remove trace residue. Dispose of recovered material as noted below. Notify appropriate environmental agency.

#### WASTE DISPOSAL METHOD

Waste management priorities (depending on volumes and concentration of waste) are 1. Recycle (reprocess), 2. Energy recovery (cement kilns, thermal power generation), 3. Incineration, 4. Disposal at a licensed waste disposal facility. Do not attempt to combust waste on site. Incinerate at a licensed waste disposal site with approval of environmental authority.

#### PRECAUTIONS TO BE TAKEN FOR SAFE HANDLING

Eliminate all ignition sources. Avoid prolonged exposure to vapours. Wear suitable gloves and eye protection. Empty containers are hazardous; may contain flammable/explosive liquid residue or vapours. Keep away from sparks and open flames. Bond and ground transfer containers and equipment to avoid static accumulation.

#### SAFE STORAGE REQUIREMENTS

**COMBUSTIBLE.** Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area, away from heat and ignition sources. Hot surfaces may be sufficient to ignite liquid even in the absence of sparks or flames. Extinguish pilot lights, cigarettes and turn off other sources of ignition prior to use and until all vapours are gone. Vapours may accumulate and travel to distant ignition sources and flashback. Use explosion proof ventilation to prevent vapour accumulation. Empty containers may contain hazardous product residues. Fixed equipment, as well as transfer containers and equipment should be grounded to prevent accumulation of static charges. Do not cut, drill, grind, weld or perform similar operations on or near containers. Keep container tightly closed. Avoid breathing vapours and prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Air dry contaminated clothing in a well ventilated area before laundering. Launder contaminated clothing prior to reuse. Use good personal hygiene.

### Section 8 - First Aid Measures

#### **SPECIFIC MEASURES:**

Inhalation: Remove victim from further exposure and restore breathing, if required. Obtain medical attention.

**Splash (eyes):** Flush eyes immediately with large amounts of water for at least 15 minutes while holding eyelids open. Take to a physician for medical treatment as soon as possible after first aid has been initiated and completed.

**Splash (skin):** Start rinsing and remove contaminated clothing while rinsing. Wash contaminated skin with mild soap and water. If irritation occurs and persists, obtain medical attention.

**Ingestion:** Do not induce vomiting. Guard against aspiration into lungs by having the individual turn on to their left side. If vomiting occurs spontaneously, keep head below hips to prevent aspiration of liquid into the lungs. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Obtain medical attention immediately.

**Notes to Physician:** The main hazard following accidental ingestion is aspiration of the liquid into the lungs producing chemical pneumonitis. If more than 2.0 ml/kg has been ingested, vomiting should be induced with supervision. If symptoms such as loss of gag reflex, convulsions or unconsciousness occur before vomiting, gastric lavage with a cuffed endotracheal tube should be considered.
